

RESOLUTION NO. 10-24

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SUPERIOR, NEBRASKA**

THAT: for electricity provided by the Utilities Department of the City of Superior, Nebraska, the following rates apply to all urban and rural residential, commercial, industrial and municipal customers, beginning with the utility billing issued on or about January 1, 2011, due on or about January 15, 2011.

**MONTHLY ELECTRIC RATES FOR RESIDENTIAL, GENERAL SERVICE
AND GENERAL SERVICE DEMAND**

Residential Service:

Large General Service:

General Service customers are all customers, including municipal customers, who are not residential and do not qualify as Large General Service customers.

Large General Service customers are determined by demand. Any customer reaching a peak demand of 100 KW or greater, in any monthly billing period, shall be a Large General Service customer for the succeeding twelve months.

Energy charge: The charge in dollars, per kilowatt hour (KWH) of measured use in a given billing month.

Demand charge: The charge in dollars, per kilowatt (KW) of measured 30 minute peak demand (corrected for power factor if necessary) in a given billing month.

APPLICABLE TO ALL RATES.

PCA Charges: Superior Utilities may pass through, as an additional charge, a Production Cost Adjustment (PCA). This charge offsets the actual cost of purchased electricity when such purchases exceed the base cost in the retail rates herein established. Actual cost is the price per KWH received from the city wholesaler on or about the 5th of each month. As established by rate study, the base cost is increased:

off-peak months (per KWH)	\$0.0494
peak months (per KWH)	\$0.0638


The PCA is the difference between the actual cost and base cost noted above.

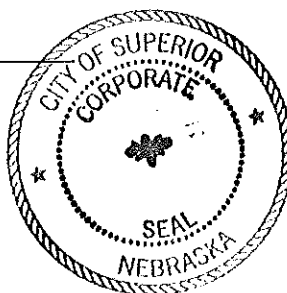
Peak/Off-Peak months: For billing purposes, June, July, August and September are peak months. All remaining months are off-peak months.


All bills shall be posted on the first of the month or first work day thereafter. All bills shall be due and payable upon receipt and delinquent if not paid by the fifteenth (15th) of the month the bill was rendered. A ten percent (10%) delayed payment penalty shall be charged on delinquent bills. Delinquent accounts shall be subject to disconnection upon proper notice.
