

RESOLUTION NO. 10-25

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SUPERIOR, NEBRASKA:**

That for water provided by the Utilities Department of the City of Superior, Nebraska, the following rates apply to all urban and rural residential, commercial, industrial and municipal customers, beginning with the utility billing issued on or about October 1, 2010, due on or about October 15, 2010.

Residential Service:

Hardy Service:

Customer Charge, per month	7.10
Balance (per 1,000 gallons)	1.833


The customer charge shall be one charge for meters manifolded as one meter.

For construction or filling large water tanks, water is available for purchase either at the tank filling point in the Utility Department Yard, or contractors may request a metered connection to a fire hydrant. The fee for the metered connection shall be \$25 due at time of connection and includes the first three units of water. The remainder of usage shall be charged at the Commercial Service Balance rate per thousand gallons. At the tank filling point the cost shall be rounded to the nearest twenty-five cents (25¢).


All bills shall be posted on the first work day of the month. All bills shall be due upon receipt and delinquent if not paid by the fifteenth (15th) day of the month the bill was rendered. A ten percent (10%) delayed payment penalty shall be charged on delinquent bills. Delinquent accounts shall be subject to disconnection upon proper notice.

IMPACT OF PROPOSED RATES

The average water use in Superior is about 15 kgal/month in the summer and 7 kgal/month in the winter.

<u>Balance</u>	<u>8.52</u>	<u>8.80</u>
Total	20.29	20.67

A difference of \$0.94 in the summer and \$0.38 in the winter
